To have your family story shared digitally in the exhibition app, I kindly ask participants to provide me with the following information:

- Please share a picture of an object that you find encapsulates your family's exile story.
- Please provide details about the object itself: [You do not have to provide an answer to each question]
 - o To whom did this object belong?
 - o What was the object's function?
 - o Of what material is it made from?
 - o Where was it made?
- What does this particular object say about your family's exile story?
- What does the object's inclusion in the exhibition mean for you personally?
- What do you hope this object will inspire within visitors to the exhibition?

Please keep your response limited to 1,000 characters (about 180 words) in length.
